CONTRACT OF ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Please read the following information carefully to ensure a common ground of understanding of River City Science Academy's foundational policies, protocols, requirements and expectations. The student agenda provided in the beginning of the year will outline the specifics of each topic.

I. Behavior and protocol:

Embedded in the educational foundation at RCSA is teaching students how to become individuals of respect and integrity. The RCSASE faculty, staff and administration work as a team to teach students the importance of thinking about their choices and actions. Time is spent identifying, discussing, teaching and modeling steps and strategies for students to apply in order for them to reach their individual potential. II. Code of Conduct policies and procedures:

RCSASE adheres strictly to the policies, protocols and consequences outlined in the Code of Conduct. Respect and responsibility are held to the highest level and there is no tolerance for repeated behaviors of disrespect, disruption of learning, refusal to learn, dishonesty or intentional rough or harmful behavior.

III. Uniform policy and purchasing:

RCSASE adheres tightly to our uniform policy as outlined in the Student Handbook. All uniform shirts/tops, and PE Uniforms (middle school only), MUST be purchased from our vendor. Bottoms must be navy or khaki in color and must be worn with a belt if they have belt loops. Cargo shorts/pants are not permitted.

IV. Parent Involvement:

Parent/guardians are required to provide RCSASE with current emergency contact information, legal documentation and guardianship (if applicable), as well as updates on any new changes within 2 business days. RCSASE relies on and requires a partnership with our parent/guardians. RCSASE main form of communication is through our parent portals such as DOJO, RCSA Connect, Constant Connect, and Email, which requires regular computer and internet access.

It is imperative that parents set aside time to read all documents/notes that come home in either the newsletter, class DOJO, Friday Folder (elementary only), or the student's agenda. RCSASE aims to send information electronically through email, but hard copies of documents are sent home to ensure that you receive the information that you need.

RCSASE educational philosophy sees home assignments as an extension or preparation of class lessons. Failure to complete assignments and/or utilize the support system in place to assist students will hinder your child's ability to maintain a successful learning experience.
